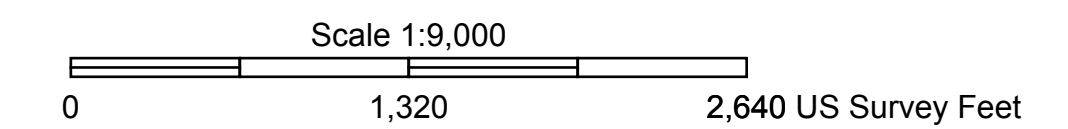

3.40	.10	Saddle between West and East
3.50	.10	West Twin Sister Summit
